

Rules relating to the "LES OSBORNE TROPHY" system Known as L.O.T

- 1. The L.O.T. commences at the April meeting and runs for 12 consecutive months
- 2. Only paid-up members will be entered into the L.O.T.
- 3. Turned items placed on the gallery table each month will be entered into the L.O.T. Items shown at a previous meeting will not be included.
- 4. Only 2 items from each member will be allocated points.
- 5. 2 points are given for the 1st turned item, 1 bonus point for the 2nd turned item.
- 6. Points are doubled up on a challenge evening, i.e. 1st item 4 points 2 nd item 2 points.
- 7. All scores will be added up after the March meeting.

 The member with the most points at the end of the March meeting is the finalist and awarded the L.O.T. at the following April meeting.

 If there should be a tie break the bonus points will be included.

 If the scores should be the same after the bonus points are added the trophy will be held equally between the finalists.
- 8. A small engraved cup will begiven to each finalist/s to keep.
- 9. The trophy must be handed back at the March meeting in time for it to be engraved, ready to be presented at the April meeting.
- 10. In a dispute the committee will endeavor to solve the issue fairly. The committee decision is final.

Reason for trophy

The L.O.T. is not a competition or judgment on a member's ability.

It's a way of awarding members who regularly participate in showing their turned work on the gallery table each month.
